- Personal Contact and Background information
- Application manuscript (in Word or PDF format)
 - > Poetry: 10 pages maximum
 - > Fiction: 25 pages (double-spaced) maximum
 - > Both
- Personal essay (3-4 pages, double-spaced, Word or PDF format) that addresses:
 - > your preparation in the study of creative writing and literature
 - > additional experiences that seem particularly relevant to this application
 - > the strengths and weaknesses of your writing
 - > your goals for your two years of degree study
- Critical analysis (3-4 pages, double-spaced, Word or PDF format) of craft:
 - ➤ in a poem if applying in poetry
 - > in a story or novel if applying in fiction
 - > if applying in both genres, submit an analytical essay for each
- **2 letters of recommendation** (References will receive an email directly from Submittable with questions and instructions to submit their letters directly.)
- **Unofficial transcripts** from each college or university you have attended. Upon acceptance, you will be required to submit official transcripts.
